ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 8

The Washington State Chiropractic Disciplinary Board gave notice to the Code Reviser (No. 2086), to other interested persons and to the press, in accordance with RCW 34.04.025 and 42.32.010 on June 27, 1968, that a hearing would be held on Saturday, July 27, 1968, at 2:00 p.m. in Room 224, Gugenheim Hall, University of Washington Campus, Seattle, Washington, to consider the adoption of rules relating to chiropractors, covering such things as office signs, telephone listings, professional cards, letterheads, announcements of office openings, representations as to free service, distribution of material and prohibiting the use of certain devices and apparatus including material to be taken internally.

The Washington State Chiropractic Disciplinary Board, after holding hearings at the time and place above specified, considered comments and oral statements made by persons in attendance and adopted the attached as permanent rules in accordance with the authority conferred by RCW 18.26.110. The board further directed that upon recording of the order in the registry of the agency the rules be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to chapter 34.04 RCW and chapter 1-12 WAC.

I hereby certify that this action was taken by the Washington State Chiropractic Disciplinary Board and is reflected in the minutes of that body, and the attached is a true and correct copy of the rules adopted.

Chapter 113-12

CHIROPRACTIC DISCIPLINARY BOARD RULES

WAC 113-12-010 IDENTIFICATION. A chiropractor must clearly identify himself as a chiropractor on his office signs.

WAC 113-12-020 TELEPHONE LISTINGS. Telephone directory listings including more than the name, address, phone number and identification as a chiropractor or of such size that a charge is made for such listing in addition to the charge for a business phone service shall be considered as advertising by the chiropractor.

WAC 113-12-030 DISPLAY OF IDENTIFICATION. No chiropractor shall display or permit the continued display on any premise geographically separated from his office or in periodicals or newspapers, professional journals and directories excluded, any card or sign identifying his chiropractic practice.

WAC 113-12-040 ANNOUNCEMENTS OF OFFICE OPENINGS. Announcements of office openings, change of location or association of another chiropractor shall not exceed a maximum of three columns wide and four inches high and shall not contain any reference to the practice of chiropractic other than that material permitted on a professional card. Such announcements can only be published within the lesser of the following maximums: Six total publications, thirty days from the date of publication.

WAC 113-12-050 MATERIAL FOR DISTRIBUTION. No chiropractor shall distribute or mail or have distributed or mailed to the general members of the public material bearing information as to the local or description of his chiropractic practice.

WAC 113-12-060 LETTERHEADS AND CARDS. Professional cards and the letterhead on stationery and bills shall not contain any material other than the name, address, office hours, telephone number, name of clinic if applicable, professional identification and professional associations.

WAC 113-12-070 REPRESENTATIONS AS TO FREE X-RAYS. No chiropractor shall make any representation as to free x-rays when the patient or his insurance carrier is charged for any services by the chiropractor.

WAC 113-12-080 VITAMINS AND FOOD SUPPLEMENTS. No chiropractor shall sell or dispense or permit to be sold or dispensed any vitamins or food supplements.
