

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 15

The Washington State Chiropractic Disciplinary Board gave notice to the Code Reviser (No. 2273), to other interested persons and to the press, in accordance with RCW 34.04.025 and 42.32.010 on March 21, 1969, that a public hearing would be held on Saturday, April 12, 1969, at 2:00 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Public Utilities Building, 3628 South 35th Street, Tacoma, Washington, to consider the amendment of WAC 113-12-020 on Telephone Listings and WAC 113-12-050 on Material For Distribution.

The Washington State Chiropractic Disciplinary Board after holding a hearing at that time and place considered comments and oral statements made by persons in attendance and at that time, in accordance with RCW 18.26.110, adopted as a permanent rule, an amendment to WAC-113-12-020 to read as attached to this order. The Board further directed that upon recording the order in the registry of the agency that the rules be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to Chapter 34.04 RCW and Chapter 1-12 WAC.

WAC 113-12-020 TELEPHONE LISTINGS. Telephone directory listings including more than the name, address, phone number, identification as a chiropractor and professional association as listed in the chiropractic act, or of such size that a charge is made for such listing in addition to the charge for business phone service, shall be considered as advertising by the chiropractor.
