I, MAX V. BROKAW, Secretary of the Washington State Chiropractic Disciplinary Board, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Board, and by virtue of the authority vested in the Board under chapter 34.04 RCW and RCW 18.26.110, and after filing Notice No. 3453 with the Code Reviser, and notifying the press in accordance with RCW 42.32.010, and also notifying interested persons of its intention to consider the adoption of a rule concerning unprofessional conduct with respect to certain billing procedures in the practice of chiropractic, held a meeting open to the public on May 27, 1972.

After considering statements made at the hearing and the material submitted, and rejecting a motion to continue the hearing to a later date, and accepting an amendment to the proposed rule to state more clearly the conduct to be proscribed, the Board hereby promulgates and adopts the annexed rule.

This Order after first being recorded in the order register of this agency, shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to chapter 34.04 RCW and chapter 1-12 WAC.
