ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 76-2

A resolution relating to permanent rules of Clark Community College District No. 14, to wit: adopting WAC 132N-10-010, integrating the provisions of the State Environmental Policy Act of 1971, and the guidelines of the Environmental Policy Council, into the capital construction approval procedures of Clark Community College District No. 14.

BE IT RESOLVED by Clark Community College District No. 14 that it adopt Administrative Order No. 76-2 and the regulation annexed hereto and made a part hereof by this reference, identified as WAC 132N-10-010, as a permanent rule after due notice and in meeting open to the public, held at Vancouver, Washington, January 18, 1977, as required by Chapter 34.04 and 42.30 RCW.

This order after being first recorded in the order register of this agency shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to Chapter 34.40 RCW and Chapter 1-12 WAC.

WAC 132N-10-010 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION POLICY. (1) It shall be the policy of Clark Community College District No. 14 that capital projects proposed and developed by the district shall comply with the provisions of Chapter 43.21C RCW, the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA); Chapter 197-10 WAC, guidelines for SEPA implementation; and WAC 131-24-030, SEPA implementation rules of the State Board for Community College Education.

(2) In compliance with WAC 197-10-820, the district president, or an administrative officer designated by the district president, shall be the "responsible official" for carrying out this policy.
