Suggestions pertaining to Order Form

1. The form furnished by the Code Reviser should be designated as an 'Official Form'
2. Section numbers to be used only when mixed order is filed. WAC 1-12-130 should probably reflect this.
3. Suggest that the Order Form CR-2 be designated as  
Authentication and Transmittal of Rules adopted  
or  
Agency Order and Transmittal of Rules adopted
4. Re: WAC 1-12-040 and 050  
Agency may use own form to go with Form CR-2
5. In cases where Government Regulations are adopted they could be omitted from WAC codification, but must be available for distribution by the agency upon request.

There may be other exceptions where the rules filed would not be codified

1. Will the Notice Form be the exclusive form used in filing?
2. Need for second page attachments
3. Notice Number will be shown in history
4. More space needed for space designated for place of meeting
5. Letter of delinquency will be mailed when the 20 day requirement is not met
6. Question as to whether the actual date of adoption be shown along with the date of first hearing
7. In (1) of Notice Form the reference to RCW 34.04.020 should be amended.  
Also: The last two lines of (1) should read to reconsider the adoption of rules concerning: etc.
7. More space should be left for additional comment
8. (3) of the Notice Form was to be amended
