We, The County Road Administration Board, find that an emergency exists and that the foregoing order is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare and that observance of the requirements of notice and opportunity to present views on the proposed action would be contrary to public interest. A statement of the facts constituting such emergency is:

The passage of ESHB 203 by the Legislature requiring the State Auditor to conduct a study relating to diversions of county road property tax revenues, which will affect the RAP project approval process.

Such rules are therefore adopted as emergency rules to take effect upon filing with the code reviser.
