The following rule was adopted:

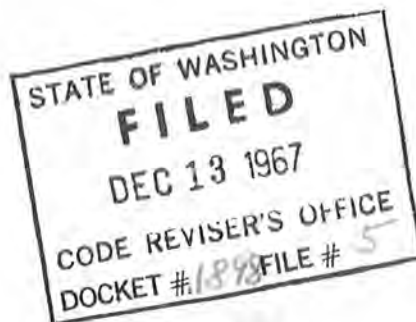
The branches of civil, mechanical, electrical and chemical engineering are given two times a year in the spring and winter. All other branches will be given in the spring only.
