Subject of Possible Rule Making: The department of social and health services (DSHS) is planning to amend WAC 388-432-0005 Can I get help from DSHS for a family emergency without receiving monthly cash assistance?, and other related rules as may be required.

Statutes Authorizing the Agency to Adopt Rules on this Subject:

RCW 74.04.050, 74.04.055, 74.04.057, 74.08.090, and 74.08A.210. Reasons Why Rules on this Subject may be Needed and What They Might Accomplish: Effective January 1, 2025, planned amendments will implement HB 2415 (chapter 154, Laws of 2024) and increase the maximum diversion cash assistance payment from \$1,250 to \$2,000. If applicable, amendments will make additional changes required to improve clarity, update policy, or better align rule language with state and federal law or regulations.
