Reasons Why Rules on this Subject may be Needed and What They Might Accomplish: The developmental disabilities administration (DDA) is planning to write a new chapter of rules to operationalize services at Lake Burien as directed by the Washington state legislature in the supplemental operating budget 2023-2025 (ESSB 5950, section 203 (1) (nn); ESSB 5950, section 227(44)).
