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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A task force is created to improve the
8 collection and reporting of data about conditions affecting the
9 education and well-being of children. The primary objective of the
10 task force is to provide data aggregated by school districts for use by
11 school districts and state and local policymakers in the planning and
12 evaluation of local and state education programs, practices, and
13 activities."

14 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) One representative shall be
15 appointed to the task force created in section 1 of this act from each
16 of the following: Office of the superintendent of public instruction,
17 department of social and health services, department of health,
18 employment security department, department of community development,
19 department of information services, office of financial management, the
20 administrator for the courts, Washington association of school
21 administrators, Washington state school directors' association, the
22 Washington state association of counties, the association of Washington
23 cities, house of representative staff, and senate staff.

24 (2) The task force shall select a chair from among its members.

25 (3) The task force shall consult with the Washington school
26 information processing cooperative, educational service districts,

1 groups representing racial and ethnic minorities, and other interested
2 parties.

3 (4) The Washington state institute for public policy shall
4 coordinate and staff the task force, and may contract for technical
5 consulting services as needed."

6 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The task force shall, by December 1,
7 1991:

8 (1) Identify the likely uses for demographic data on the education
9 and well-being of children, and determine what type of data is needed,
10 or would be useful, in the planning and evaluation of local and state
11 education programs, practices, and activities;

12 (2) Determine the feasibility, cost, and actions required to
13 aggregate the data identified in subsection (1) of this section by
14 school districts;

15 (3) Determine the feasibility, cost, and actions required to report
16 the data identified in subsection (1) of this section to school
17 districts and state and local policymakers, ensuring that quality
18 control and appropriate confidentiality and privacy safeguards are
19 provided;

20 (4) Identify measures necessary to ensure the adequate collection
21 and reporting of the data, including the use of common data definitions
22 and reporting timelines;

23 (5) Implement those actions that can be taken with little or no
24 cost, and identify actions, with proposed timelines, in which
25 additional resources are required;

26 (6) Examine related issues as the task force deems appropriate; and

27 (7) Report to the appropriate committees of the legislature its
28 findings, specific actions taken to improve data collection and
29 reporting, and what additional actions and resources are needed to

1 further improve data collection and reporting on the well-being and
2 education of children."

3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. If specific funding for the purposes of
4 this act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June
5 30, 1991, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act shall be null and
6 void."

7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. This act shall expire December 1, 1991."

8 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. This act is necessary for the immediate
9 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
10 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
11 effect immediately."

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15 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "well-being;" strike the
16 remainder of the title and insert "creating new sections; providing an
17 expiration date; and declaring an emergency."
