9 On page 9, after line 29, insert the following:

10 "Sec. 4. RCW 9.46.0315 and 1987 c 4 s 27 are each amended to  
11 read as follows:

12 Bona fide charitable or bona fide nonprofit organizations  
13 organized primarily for purposes other than the conduct of raffles,  
14 are hereby authorized to conduct raffles without obtaining a  
15 license to do so from the commission when such raffles are held in  
16 accordance with all other requirements of this chapter, other  
17 applicable laws, and rules of the commission; when gross revenues  
18 from all such raffles held by the organization during the calendar  
19 year do not exceed five thousand dollars; and when tickets to such  
20 raffles are sold only to, and winners are determined only from  
21 among, the regular members of the organization conducting the  
22 raffle. The organization may provide unopened containers of

1 beverages containing alcohol as raffle prizes if the appropriate  
2 permit has been obtained from the liquor control board: PROVIDED,  
3 That the term members for this purpose shall mean only those  
4 persons who have become members prior to the commencement of the  
5 raffle and whose qualification for membership was not dependent  
6 upon, or in any way related to, the purchase of a ticket, or  
7 tickets, for such raffles."

10 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "66.24.170," strike "and  
11 66.24.210" and insert "66.24.210, and 9.46.0315"

EFFECT: Allows a bona fide charitable or nonprofit  
organization to offer unopened bottles of liquor as prizes at  
raffles.
