6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.46
8 RCW to read as follows:

9 (1) Upon request of an Indian tribe as defined in P.L. 100-497, the
10 gambling commission shall designate a negotiating team to implement
11 P.L. 100-497, Sec.11(d)(3)(A) by negotiating with the tribe for the
12 purpose of entering into a tribal-state compact. The commission shall
13 be advised by the attorney general's office and shall consult with the
14 governor, the state patrol, the lottery commission, the horse racing
15 commission, and interested local governments during the course of
16 negotiations.

17 (2) The commission shall conduct at least one public hearing and
18 provide an opportunity for public comment on any proposed compact.
19 Upon completion of the public hearing process and upon a majority vote
20 of all of its members, the commission shall by single resolution either
21 remand the proposal for further negotiations, or approve the proposal.
22 If approved, the commission shall immediately forward the compact to
23 the chief clerk of the house of representatives and the secretary of
24 the senate. Within thirty days each house of the legislature shall
25 vote by floor resolution, its approval or disapproval of the proposed
26 compact and forward its recommendations to the governor.

27 (3) In the event the legislature has not convened or is not
28 expected to be convened in regular or special session during the thirty

1 day review period the chief clerk and the secretary shall conduct the
2 vote on the compact by written ballot of the members of their
3 respective houses under such procedures as may be ordered by the
4 committee on rules of their houses. The vote shall be transmitted to
5 the members of the legislature and shall be a public record and shall
6 be entered upon the journal of the houses at the convening of the next
7 legislative session.

8 (4) Within thirty days of receipt of the floor resolutions from the
9 house and the senate, the governor shall either approve or reject the
10 compact. If rejected it shall be remanded to the gambling commission
11 for further negotiation. Any subsequent proposed compact shall be
12 presented to the legislature pursuant to the procedures contained in
13 this section."

14 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate
15 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
16 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
17 effect immediately."
