1 AN ACT Relating to tuition and fee waivers; and amending RCW
2 28B.15.535.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.535 and 1985 c 390 s 28 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The boards of regents of the state universities and the boards
7 of trustees of regional universities, The Evergreen State College, and
8 community colleges may waive the tuition and services and activities
9 fees for full-time employees of their respective institutions of higher
10 education and for members of the Washington national guard enrolled in
11 said institutions' courses on a space available basis pursuant to the
12 following conditions:

13 (a) Employees of the institutions and members of the Washington
14 national guard shall register for and be enrolled in courses on a space

1 available basis, and no new course sections shall be created as a
2 direct result of such registration;

3 (b) Enrollment information on employees and on members of the
4 Washington national guard registered on a space available basis shall
5 be maintained separately from other enrollment information and shall
6 not be included in official enrollment reports, nor shall persons
7 enrolled pursuant to the provisions of this section be considered in
8 any enrollment statistics which would affect budgetary determinations;

9 (c) Employees of the institutions and members of the Washington
10 national guard registering on a space available basis shall be charged
11 a registration fee (~~((of not less than five dollars))~~) that will fully
12 cover institutional costs of administering the student's enrollment.

13 (2) The governing boards of the respective colleges and
14 universities may waive tuition and services and activities fees for
15 full-time intercollegiate center for nursing education, cooperative
16 extension service, and agricultural research employees of Washington
17 State University for such employees stationed off the Pullman, Whitman
18 county campus: PROVIDED, That such waiver complies with the conditions
19 spelled out in subsection (1) (a), (b), and (c) (~~((above))~~) of this
20 section.

21 (3) The boards of regents of the state universities, the boards of
22 trustees of the regional universities and The Evergreen State College,
23 and the state board for community college education with respect to
24 community colleges, shall adopt guidelines for the implementation of
25 employee and Washington national guard waivers granted pursuant to this
26 section.

27 (4) No waivers shall be granted for members of the Washington
28 national guard after June 30, 1996.
