AN ACT Relating to compulsive gambling; amending RCW 67.70.240 and 67.16.105; adding new sections to chapter 9.46 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 67.70 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that:

6 (1) The state, through the activities of the state lottery 7 commission, Washington state gambling commission, and Washington horse 8 racing commission, is actively involved in promoting and regulating 9 gambling and bears a direct responsibility to identify and address 10 problems created or exacerbated by the presence of legalized gambling 11 in Washington state;

(2) Compulsive gambling is a serious personal and social problem, and there is evidence that a significant percentage of the population is currently affected and that increasing the availability of gambling increases the risk that more citizens will become dependent upon gambling; and

(3) The state recognizes the responsibility to address the issue ofproblem gambling by establishing appropriate programs and providing

1 funding to further the understanding, assessment, and treatment of 2 problem gambling.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9.46 RCW 4 to read as follows:

5 The commission, state lottery commission, and Washington horse 6 racing commission, shall provide the following services:

7 (1) Maintain and actively promote a toll-free telephone number 8 providing crisis counseling and referral services to individuals and 9 families experiencing difficulty as a result of problem or compulsive 10 gambling;

(2) Establish and expand public awareness programs that include,
but are not limited to, brochures and other printed materials and
public service announcements;

14 (3) Facilitate the availability of effective assistance programs15 for problem or compulsive gamblers;

16 (4) Conduct ongoing studies to identify populations of adults and 17 adolescents who are, or who are at risk of becoming, problem or 18 compulsive gamblers; and

19 (5) Create an adolescent prevention program on pathological20 gambling.

The commission may contract with a nonprofit, state-based organization to carry out the services provided under this section.

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 9.46 RCW 24 to read as follows:

The compulsive gambling account is created in the custody of the 25 state treasurer. All receipts from the commission, state lottery 26 27 commission, and Washington horse racing commission under sections 4 and 28 6 of this act and RCW 67.16.105 shall be deposited into the account. 29 Expenditures from the account may be used only for the purposes of section 2 of this act. Only the chairman of the commission may 30 authorize expenditures from the compulsive gambling account. 31 The 32 account is subject to allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but 33 no appropriation is required for expenditures. The state treasurer may receive gifts, grants, donations, devises, and bequests of moneys for 34 35 this account from governmental agencies, public or private entities, or individuals who may be interested in making contributions for the 36 purpose of this section. 37

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 67.70 RCW
 to read as follows:

3 The commission shall deposit an amount equal to one-twentieth of 4 one percent of the annual gross lottery revenues per year into the 5 compulsive gambling account established under section 3 of this act.

6 **Sec. 5.** RCW 67.70.240 and 1987 c 513 s 7 are each amended to read 7 as follows:

8 The moneys in the state lottery account shall be used only: (1) 9 For the payment of prizes to the holders of winning lottery tickets or shares; (2) for purposes of making deposits into the reserve account 10 created by RCW 67.70.250 and into the lottery administrative account 11 12 created by RCW 67.70.260; (3) for purposes of making deposits into the state's general fund; (4) ((for purposes of making deposits into the 13 14 housing trust fund under the provisions of section 7 of this 1987 act; 15 (5)) for the purchase and promotion of lottery games and game-related 16 services; ((and (6))) (5) for the payment of agent compensation; and (6) for the purpose of section 2 of this act. 17

The office of financial management shall require the allotment of all expenses paid from the account and shall report to the ways and means committees of the senate and house of representatives any changes in the allotments.

22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 9.46 RCW 23 to read as follows:

The commission shall deposit an amount equal to two and one-half percent of the annual license fees per year collected by the commission into the compulsive gambling account established under section 3 of this act.

28 **Sec. 7.** RCW 67.16.105 and 1991 c 270 s 6 are each amended to read 29 as follows:

(1) Licensees of race meets that are nonprofit in nature, are of ten days or less, and have an average daily handle of one hundred twenty thousand dollars or less shall withhold and pay to the commission daily for each authorized day of racing one-half percent of the daily gross receipts from all parimutuel machines at each race meet.

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1 (2) Licensees of race meets that do not fall under subsection (1) 2 of this section shall withhold and pay to the commission daily for each 3 authorized day of racing the following applicable percentage of all 4 daily gross receipts from all parimutuel machines at each race meet: 5 (a) If the daily gross receipts of all parimutuel machines are more 6 than two hundred fifty thousand dollars, the licensee shall withhold 7 and pay to the commission daily two and one-half percent of the daily

8 gross receipts; and

9 (b) If the daily gross receipts of all parimutuel machines are two 10 hundred fifty thousand dollars or less, the licensee shall withhold and 11 pay to the commission daily one percent of the daily gross receipts.

12 (3) In addition to those amounts in subsections (1) and (2) of this 13 section, all licensees shall forward one-tenth of one percent of the daily gross receipts of all parimutuel machines to the commission daily 14 15 for payment to those nonprofit race meets as set forth in RCW 67.16.130 16 and subsection (1) of this section((, but said percentage shall not be charged against the licensees)). The total of such payments shall not 17 exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars in any one year ((and any 18 19 amount in excess of one hundred fifty thousand dollars shall be The commission shall, after the 20 remitted to the general fund)). payment under RCW 67.16.130, forward the one-tenth of one percent of 21 the daily gross receipts to the compulsive gambling account as 22 established in section 3 of this act; the payment may not exceed 23 24 seventy-five thousand dollars in any one year and an amount in excess 25 of two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars must be remitted to the 26 general fund, but the percentage may not be charged against the Payments to nonprofit race meets under this subsection 27 licensees. shall be distributed on a pro rata per-race-day basis and used only for 28 purses at race tracks that have been operating under RCW 67.16.130 and 29 subsection (1) of this section for the five consecutive years 30 immediately preceding the year of payment. 31

(4) In addition to those sums paid to the commission in subsection (2) of this section, licensees who are nonprofit corporations and have race meets of thirty days or more shall withhold and pay to the commission daily for each authorized day of racing an amount equal to two and one-half percent of the daily gross receipts of all parimutuel machines at each race meet. Said percentage shall come from that amount the licensee is authorized to retain under RCW 67.16.170(2).

- 2 thoroughbred racing fund created in RCW 67.16.250.

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
