1 AN ACT Relating to bidding on public works; amending RCW 39.30.060;
2 and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 39.30.060 and 1993 c 378 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Every invitation to bid on a contract that is expected to cost in
7 excess of one hundred thousand dollars for the construction,
8 alteration, or repair of any public building or public work of the
9 state or a state agency or municipality as defined under RCW 39.04.010,
10 an institution of higher education as defined under RCW 28B.10.016, or
11 a school district shall require each bidder to submit as part of the
12 bid, or within (~~twenty-four~~) one hour(~~s~~) of the published bid time,
13 the names of the subcontractors whose subcontract amount is more than
14 ten percent of the contract price with whom the bidder, if awarded the
15 contract, will subcontract for performance of the categories of work
16 designated on the list to be submitted with the bid or to indicate by
17 naming itself that a category of work on the list shall not be
18 subcontracted. Failure to name such subcontractors or itself shall
19 render the bidder's bid nonresponsive and, therefore, void.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act applies prospectively only and not
2 retroactively. It applies only to invitations to bid issued on or
3 after the effective date of this act.
