to read as follows:

6 The prosecuting attorney of the county in which such action is 7 taken may, at the discretion of the prosecuting attorney, represent the 8 designated chemical dependency specialist or treatment program in 9 judicial proceedings under RCW 70.96A.140 for the involuntary 10 commitment or recommitment of an individual, including any judicial 11 proceeding where the individual sought to be committed or recommitted 12 challenges the action.
