- 9 intent, contracts ((shall)) may be awarded to the next lowest
- 10 <u>responsible</u> bidder <u>in turn</u>, or all bids may be rejected and new bids
- 11 obtained, if the lowest <u>responsible</u> bidder does not meet the goals
- 12 established for a particular contract under this chapter. The dollar
