- 9 to participate in state contracts for purchases administered by the
- 10 office of state procurement. Such agreement must comply with the
- 11 requirements of RCW 39.34.030 through 39.34.050. For the purposes of
- 12 this section "public benefit nonprofit corporation" means a public
- 13 benefit nonprofit corporation as defined in RCW 24.03.005 that is
