8 "(b) Minors may not be employed in:

9 (i) Occupations where there is a risk of exposure to bodily  
10 fluids or transmission of infectious agents, including but not  
11 limited to hepatitis and HIV, including lab work which entails  
12 the cleaning of medical equipment used to draw or store blood or  
13 other contaminated tissue; duties which involve venipuncture; and  
14 duties involving work with laundry from health care facilities.  
15 This subsection(b)(i) does not apply if the minor is a student in  
16 a bona fide health care career training or vocational education  
17 program. State-certified life guards with first aid training are  
18 exempt.

19 (ii) Occupations involving potential exposure to hazardous  
20 substances which are considered to be carcinogenic, corrosive,  
21 highly toxic, toxic sensitizers, or which have been determined to  
22 cause reproductive health effects or irreversible end organ  
23 damage. This does not include handling of such substances in  
24 sealed containers in retail situations. This subsection's  
25 prohibitions shall not apply to any consumer product or hazardous  
26 substance, as those terms are defined by the consumer product  
27 safety act (15 U.S.C. 2051 et seq.) and the federal hazardous  
28 substances act (15 U.S.C. 1261 et seq.) and those statutes'  
29 regulations, where the employer of a minor can demonstrate that a  
30 product or substance is used in the workplace in the same manner

1 as normal consumer use, and which use results in a duration and  
2 frequency of exposure that is not greater than exposures  
3 experienced by consumers using the product or substance in  
4 conformity with the manufacturer's instructions."

**EFFECT:** Adds certain infectious and hazardous occupational duties to prohibited duties under the act.
