3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.06.040 and 1987 c 518 s 107 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 The ((superintendent of public instruction)) state board for 7 community and technical colleges is authorized and directed, whenever possible, to fund or cooperatively work with existing adult literacy 8 9 programs and parenting related programs offered through the common 10 school and community and technical college systems((, vocationaltechnical institutes,)) or community-based, nonprofit organizations to 11 12 provide services for eligible parents before developing and funding new 13 adult literacy programs to carry out the purposes of project even 14 start.

15 Sec. 2. RCW 28B.06.050 and 1987 c 518 s 108 are each amended to 16 read as follows:

17 The ((superintendent of public instruction shall evaluate and 18 submit to the legislature by January 15, 1988, a report on the
