- 1 AN ACT Relating to game fish catch record cards; and amending RCW
- 2 77.32.050, 77.32.060, 77.32.070, 77.32.090, 77.32.250, 77.32.256, and
- 3 77.32.360.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.050 and 1987 c 506 s 77 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Licenses, permits, tags, and stamps((, and punchcards)) required by
- 8 this chapter shall be issued under the authority of the commission.
- 9 The director may authorize department personnel, county auditors, or
- 10 other reputable citizens to issue licenses, permits, tags, and
- 11 stamps((, and punchcards)) and collect the appropriate fees. The
- 12 authorized persons shall pay on demand or before the tenth day of the
- 13 following month the fees collected and shall make reports as required
- 14 by the director. The director may adopt rules for issuing licenses,
- 15 permits, tags, and stamps, ((and punchcards,)) collecting and paying
- 16 fees, and making reports.
- 17 **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.32.060 and 1987 c 506 s 78 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:

- 1 The director may adopt rules establishing the amount a license
- 2 dealer may charge and keep for each license, tag, permit, or stamp((-
- 3 or punchcard)) issued. The director shall establish the amount to be
- 4 retained by dealers to be at least fifty cents for each license issued,
- 5 and twenty-five cents for each tag, permit, or stamp((, or punchcard))
- 6 issued. The director shall report to the next regular session of the
- 7 legislature explaining any increase in the amount retained by license
- 8 dealers. Fees retained by dealers shall be uniform throughout the
- 9 state.
- 10 **Sec. 3.** RCW 77.32.070 and 1987 c 506 s 79 are each amended to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 Applicants for a license, permit, tag, <u>or</u> stamp((, or punchcard))
- 13 shall furnish the information required by the director. The director
- 14 may adopt rules requiring licensees or permittees to keep records and
- 15 make reports concerning the taking of wildlife.
- 16 **Sec. 4.** RCW 77.32.090 and 1987 c 506 s 80 are each amended to read
- 17 as follows:
- 18 The director may adopt rules pertaining to the form, period of
- 19 validity, use, possession, and display of licenses, permits, tags, and
- 20 stamps((, and punchcards)) required by this chapter.
- 21 **Sec. 5.** RCW 77.32.250 and 1981 c 310 s 29 are each amended to read
- 22 as follows:
- Licenses, permits, tags, <u>and</u> stamps((, and punchcards)) required by
- 24 this chapter shall not be transferred and, unless otherwise provided in
- 25 this chapter, are void on January 1st following the year ((in)) for
- 26 which the license, permit, tag, or stamp((, or punchcard)) was issued.
- 27 Upon request of a wildlife agent or ex officio wildlife agent,
- 28 persons licensed, operating under a permit, or possessing wildlife
- 29 under the authority of this chapter shall produce required licenses,
- 30 permits, tags, or stamps((, or punchcards)) for inspection and write
- 31 their signatures for comparison and in addition display their wildlife.
- 32 Failure to comply with the request is prima facie evidence that the
- 33 person has no license or is not the person named.
- 34 **Sec. 6.** RCW 77.32.256 and 1994 c 255 s 13 are each amended to read
- 35 as follows:

- The director shall by rule establish the conditions for issuance of duplicate licenses, rebates, permits, tags, <u>and</u> stamps((, and catch record cards)) required by this chapter. The fee for a duplicate provided under this section is ten dollars for those licenses that are ten dollars and over, and for those licenses under ten dollars the duplicate fee is the value of the license.
- 7 **Sec. 7.** RCW 77.32.360 and 1991 sp.s. c 7 s 10 are each amended to 8 read as follows:
- 9 (1) ((A steelhead catch record card is required to fish for 10 steelhead trout. The fee for this catch record card is eighteen 11 dollars.
- 12 (2) Persons possessing steelhead trout shall immediately validate
 13 their catch record card as provided by rule.
- 14 (3) The steelhead catch record card required under this section 15 expires April 30th following the date of issuance.
- (4)) Each person who returns a steelhead catch record card to an authorized license dealer ((by June 1)) within thirty days following the period for which it was issued shall be given a credit equal to five dollars towards that day's purchase of any license, permit, transport tag, ((catch record card,)) or stamp required by this chapter. This subsection does not apply to annual steelhead catch record cards for persons under the age of fifteen.
- (((5) Persons under the age of fifteen may purchase an annual steelhead catch record card for six dollars. The six-dollar catch record card entitles the holder to retain no more than five steelhead.

 After retaining five steelhead, a new catch record card may be purchased.))
- 28 (2) Catch record cards necessary for proper management of the 29 state's game fish resources shall be administered under rules adopted 30 by the director and issued at no charge.
