- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 48.05.310 and 1982 c 181 s 17 are each amended to read as follows: 5
- 6 (1) An insurer appointing any person as its general agent or manager to represent it as such in this state shall file notice of the 7 appointment with the commissioner on forms prescribed and furnished by 8
- 9 the commissioner.
- 10 (2) Any such general agent or manager shall have such authority,
- consistent with this code, as may be conferred by the insurer. A 11
- general agent resident in this state and licensed, as in this section 12
- 13 provided, may exercise the powers conferred by this code upon agents
- 14 licensed for the kinds of insurance which the general agent is
- 15 authorized to transact for the insurer so appointing him.
- 16 (3) Any such general agent may accept applications for insurance
- 17 from licensed agents who are not appointed by the insurer of such
- general agent where the risk involved is placed in a nonstandard or 18
