1 AN ACT Relating to moneys held by a county in trust for school
2 districts; adding a new section to chapter 36.01 RCW; and repealing an
3 act for the protection of the Joshua Brown school fund on pages 219
4 through 223, Laws of 1875.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 36.01 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 Any county authorized by territorial law to administer moneys held
9 in trust for the benefit of school districts within the county, which
10 moneys were bequeathed for such purposes by testamentary provision, may
11 dissolve any trust, the corpus of which does not exceed fifty thousand
12 dollars, and distribute any moneys remaining in the trust to school
13 districts within the county. Before dissolving the trust, the county
14 must adopt a resolution finding that conditions have changed and it is
15 no longer feasible for the county to administer the trust.

16 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** An act for the protection of the Joshua
17 Brown school fund, pages 219 through 223, Laws of 1875, are each
18 repealed.
