1 AN ACT Relating to inactive status for physical therapists; and 2 adding a new section to chapter 18.74 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.74 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 Any physical therapist licensed under this chapter not practicing 7 physical therapy or providing services may place his or her license in 8 an inactive status. The board shall prescribe requirements for 9 maintaining an inactive status and converting from an inactive or 10 active status. The secretary may establish fees for alterations in 11 license status.
