2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.19.170 and 1996 c 191 s 6 are each amended to read 4 as follows:

5 A certificate issued under this chapter shall be renewed as provided in RCW 43.70.250 and 43.70.280. The secretary ((may)) shall 6 7 establish continuing competence requirements by rule in consultation with the mental health quality assurance council. Certified counselors 8 are responsible for obtaining thirty-six clock hours of continuing 9 10 education during the two-year reporting period immediately preceding renewal of certification, including subjects in professional ethics and 11 12 law.
