AN ACT Relating to decreasing the employee contribution rate for the Washington state patrol retirement system until June 30, 2001; amending RCW 43.43.300; and providing an expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.43.300 and 1965 c 8 s 43.43.300 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

Beginning on July 1, ((1963)) <u>2000</u>, every Washington state patrol employee who is a member of the retirement fund shall contribute ((seven)) <u>three</u> percent of his <u>or her</u> monthly salary, which shall be deducted from the compensation of each member on each and every payroll.

In event a member severs his <u>or her</u> connection with the Washington state patrol or is dismissed, the amount paid by the state of Washington shall remain in the retirement fund.
