5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 **"NEW SECTION.** **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that:

8 (1) International trade is an integral part of the state's economy;  
9 (2) Washington's economy is vital to the Pacific Northwest region,  
10 which includes several states and Canadian provinces;

11 (3) Increasing global competition may require economic policies  
12 that build on the strengths of the region and create ongoing  
13 opportunities for the sale of Washington's goods and services;

14 (4) Greater efficiency through cooperation with other states and  
15 Canadian provinces within the region will benefit businesses in the  
16 region, as well as in Washington.

17 It is the intent of this act to increase the overseas promotion of  
18 Washington's goods and services by colocating, where feasible and  
19 advantageous, the state's trade offices or offices of the state's  
20 foreign representative contractors with comparable offices of other  
21 states and Canadian provinces.

22 **NEW SECTION.** **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.23 RCW  
23 to read as follows:

24 (1) The director of the department may enter into contracts with  
25 port districts, commodity commissions, or other appropriate state or  
26 regional organizations for the purpose of:

27 (a) Establishing foreign trade offices designed to promote the  
28 export of Washington food and agricultural products; or

29 (b) Contracting with overseas representatives to promote the export  
30 of Washington's food and agricultural products.

31 (2) The department shall report to the appropriate committees of  
32 the legislature on the results of the export promotion efforts under  
33 this section and recommendations for improvements.

1       **Sec. 3.** RCW 43.23.035 and 1995 c 399 s 70 are each amended to read  
2 as follows:

3       The department of agriculture is hereby designated as the agency of  
4 state government for the administration and implementation of state  
5 agricultural market development programs and activities, both domestic  
6 and foreign, and shall, in addition to the powers and duties otherwise  
7 imposed by law, have the following powers and duties:

8           (1) To study the potential marketability of various agricultural  
9 commodities of this state in foreign and domestic trade;

10          (2) To collect, prepare, and analyze foreign and domestic market  
11 data;

12          (3) To establish a program to promote and assist in the marketing  
13 of Washington-bred horses: PROVIDED, That the department shall present  
14 a proposal to the legislature no later than December 1, 1986, that  
15 provides for the elimination of all state funding for the program after  
16 June 30, 1989;

17          (4) To encourage and promote the sale of Washington's agricultural  
18 commodities and products at the site of their production through the  
19 development and dissemination of referral maps and other means;

20          (5) To encourage and promote those agricultural industries, such as  
21 the wine industry, which attract visitors to rural areas in which other  
22 agricultural commodities and products are produced and are, or could  
23 be, made available for sale;

24          (6) To encourage and promote the establishment and use of public  
25 markets in this state for the sale of Washington's agricultural  
26 products;

27          (7) To maintain close contact with foreign firms and governmental  
28 agencies and to act as an effective intermediary between foreign  
29 nations and Washington traders;

30          (8) To publish and disseminate to interested citizens and others  
31 information which will aid in carrying out the purposes of chapters  
32 43.23, 15.64, 15.65, and 15.66 RCW;

33          (9) To encourage and promote the movement of foreign and domestic  
34 agricultural goods through the ports of Washington;

35          (10) To conduct an active program by sending representatives to, or  
36 engaging representatives in, foreign countries to promote the state's  
37 agricultural commodities and products;

1       (11) To assist and to make Washington agricultural concerns more  
2 aware of the potentials of foreign trade and to encourage production of  
3 those commodities that will have high export potential and appeal;

4           (12) To coordinate the trade promotional activities of appropriate  
5 federal, state, and local public agencies, as well as civic  
6 organizations; ((and))

7       (13) To locate trade offices or contract with foreign  
8 representatives to promote the export of Washington's food and  
9 agricultural products. Where feasible, advantageous, and consistent  
10 with the goals and objectives of the department, the director may  
11 collocate a trade office or cooperate in contracting overseas  
12 representatives with port districts, commodity commissions, or other  
13 appropriate state or regional organizations; and

14       (14) To develop a coordinated marketing program with the department  
15 of community, trade, and economic development, utilizing existing trade  
16 offices and participating in mutual trade missions and activities.

17 As used in this section, "agricultural commodities" includes  
18 products of both terrestrial and aquatic farming.

19       **Sec. 4.** RCW 43.31.145 and 1991 c 24 s 7 are each amended to read  
20 as follows:

(1) The department is charged with the primary role within state government for the establishment and operation of foreign offices ((created for the purpose of promoting)) or contract with foreign representatives to promote overseas trade and commerce.

25       (2) The department, where feasible, advantageous, and consistent  
26 with the goals and objectives of the department, may colocate a trade  
27 office or cooperate in contracting overseas representatives with states  
28 or Canadian provinces."

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32 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "services;" strike the  
33 remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 43.23.035 and

1 43.31.145; adding a new section to chapter 43.23 RCW; and creating a  
2 new section."

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
