5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
8 to read as follows:

9 In cooperation with the Washington state patrol and the department,
10 the fairs commission established under RCW 15.76.170 shall create and
11 design, and the department shall issue, a special fair license plate
12 displaying a symbol representing the categories of fairs defined in RCW
13 15.76.120. The special fair license plate may be used in lieu of
14 regular or personalized license plates for motor vehicles required to
15 display two motor vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles registered
16 under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the
17 department.

18 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.16.313 and 1997 c 291 s 8 are each amended to read
19 as follows:

20 (1) The department may establish a fee for each type of special
21 license plates issued under RCW 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as
22 existing before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in
23 an amount calculated to offset the cost of production of the special
24 license plates and the administration of this program. Until December
25 31, 1997, the fee shall not exceed thirty-five dollars, but effective
26 with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 1998, the
27 department may adjust the fee to no more than forty dollars. This fee
28 is in addition to all other fees required to register and license the
29 vehicle for which the plates have been requested. All such additional
30 special license plate fees collected by the department shall be
31 deposited in the state treasury and credited to the motor vehicle fund.

32 (2) Until December 31, 1997, in addition to all fees and taxes
33 required to be paid upon application, registration, and renewal
34 registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a collegiate license
35 plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct

1 an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this
2 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.
3 The remaining proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be
4 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
5 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the
6 funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in
7 RCW 28B.10.890.

8 (3) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on
9 January 1, 1998, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
10 upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a
11 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars.
12 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of
13 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and
14 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be
15 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
16 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the
17 funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in
18 RCW 28B.10.890.

19 (4) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January
20 1, 1999, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
21 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate
22 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall
23 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under
24 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by
25 it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the
26 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state
27 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license
28 plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

29 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
30 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a
31 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of
32 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
33 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
34 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
35 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to
36 a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments
37 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as
38 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary
39 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW

1 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds
2 to the state general fund.

3 (6) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January
4 1, 1999, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
5 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special
6 baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The
7 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee
8 collected under this subsection for administration and collection
9 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed
10 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest
11 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium,
12 as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary
13 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW
14 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds
15 to the state general fund.

16 (7) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on
17 January 1, 2003, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
18 upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a
19 special fair license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars.
20 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of
21 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and
22 collection of expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be
23 deposited in the state treasury and credited to the fair fund created
24 under RCW 15.76.115.

25 (8) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January
26 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
27 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special fair
28 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall
29 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under
30 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by
31 it. The remaining proceeds shall be deposited in the state treasury
32 and credited to the fair fund created under RCW 15.76.115."
