1 TO THE HONORABLE GARY LOCKE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON,  
2 AND TO THE HONORABLE SID MORRISON, SECRETARY OF THE WASHINGTON STATE  
3 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION:

4 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of  
5 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully  
6 represent and petition as follows:

7 WHEREAS, Lieutenant J.G. Scott Walter Kinkele was murdered on July  
8 28, 2000, on Highway 20 in Skagit County while driving his car; and

9 WHEREAS, Lieutenant J.G. Kinkele was a graduate of the Naval  
10 Academy, was stationed at Whidbey Naval Air Station at the time of his  
11 death and planned to serve his country for many years to come; and

12 WHEREAS, Lieutenant J.G. Kinkele was considered an outstanding  
13 person and one of the best and brightest Naval Officers;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the  
15 Department of Transportation erect a memorial to Lieutenant J.G.  
16 Kinkele at the location on Highway 20 where he was killed.

17 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this memorial be immediately  
18 transmitted to the Honorable Gary Locke, Governor of the State of

1 Washington, and to the Honorable Sid Morrison, Secretary of the  
2 Washington State Department of Transportation.
