1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE W. BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES,
2 AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, The upland aquaculture industry in Washington state
9 produces high-quality, pathogen-free, nonanadromous upland products for
10 sale to public agencies and private companies throughout the world; and

11 WHEREAS, Washington state's upland aquaculture industry employs
12 hundreds of people in well-paying, technical positions located in many
13 rural communities throughout the state, generating forty million
14 dollars worth of products; and

15 WHEREAS, Canadian customers have expressed the desire to purchase
16 high-quality aquacultural products from Washington state producers; and

17 WHEREAS, Many customers in the United States currently purchase
18 aquacultural products from Canada; and

19 WHEREAS, Increased freedom to engage in the commercial trade of
20 upland aquacultural products between the United States and Canada will
21 only help our two nations grow more prosperous;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
2 government of the United States emphasize the importance of the free
3 and fair trade of upland aquacultural products in its relations with
4 the government of Canada.

5 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
6 transmitted to the Honorable George W. Bush, President of the United
7 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
8 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
9 Washington.
