- 1 AN ACT Relating to the investigation of alien banks; and amending

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 30.42.140 and 1994 c 92 s 91 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The director, without previous notice, shall visit the office of an
- 7 alien bank doing business in this state pursuant to this chapter at
- 8 least once ((in each year)) every eighteen months, and more often if
- 9 necessary, for the purpose of making a full investigation into the
- 10 condition of such office, and for that purpose they are hereby
- 11 empowered to administer oaths and to examine under oath any director or
- 12 member of its governing body, officer, employee, or agent of such alien
- 13 bank or office. The director shall make such other full or partial
- 14 examination as he or she deems necessary. The director shall collect,
- 15 from each alien bank for each examination of the conditions of its
- 16 office in this state, the estimated actual cost of such examination.
