- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 15.17.243 and 1999 c 47 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The district manager for district two as defined in WAC 16-458-075
- 7 is authorized to transfer two hundred thousand dollars from the fruit
- 8 and vegetable district fund to the plant pest account within the
- 9 agricultural local fund. The amount transferred is to be derived from
- 10 fees collected for state inspections of tree fruits and is to be used
- 11 solely for activities related to the control of Rhagoletis pomonella in
