- 1 AN ACT Relating to agricultural products purchased for state
- 2 institutions and state-supported facilities; adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 43.19 RCW; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that state-produced
- 6 agricultural products are of the highest quality, transported the least
- 7 distance, and are the freshest agricultural products available in
- 8 Washington state. The legislature further finds that providing
- 9 improved markets for the richly diversified agricultural commodities
- 10 produced in Washington is needed to stabilize and enhance the rural and
- 11 agricultural economies in Washington.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.19 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (1) The department of general administration, through the state
- 15 purchasing and material control director, shall encourage each state
- 16 and local agency doing business with the department to purchase
- 17 Washington fruit, vegetables, and agricultural products when available.

- 1 (2) The department of general administration shall work with the 2 department of agriculture and other interested parties to identify and
- 3 recommend strategies to increase public purchasing of Washington fruit,
- 4 vegetables, and agricultural products, and report back orally to the
- 5 appropriate committees of the legislature in September 2002, and in
- 6 January 2003.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 9 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 10 immediately.
