- AN ACT Relating to transferring service credit and contributions into the Washington state patrol retirement system by members who served as commercial vehicle enforcement officers and who became commissioned officers in the Washington state patrol after July 1, 2000, and prior to June 30, 2001; and adding a new section to chapter 41.40 RCW.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.40 RCW 9 to read as follows:
- 10 (1) Active members of the Washington state patrol retirement system
 11 who have previously established service credit in the public employees'
- 12 retirement system plan 2 while employed in the state patrol as a
- 13 commercial vehicle enforcement officer, and who became a commissioned
- 14 officer after July 1, 2000, and prior to June 30, 2001, have the
- 15 following options:
- 16 (a) Remain a member of the public employees' retirement system; or
- 17 (b) Transfer service credit earned under the retirement system as
- 18 a commercial vehicle enforcement officer to the Washington state patrol
- 19 retirement system by making an irrevocable choice filed in writing with

- department of retirement systems within one year of 1 the 2 department's announcement of the ability to make such a transfer.
- 3 (2)(a) Any commissioned officer choosing to transfer under this 4 section shall have transferred from the retirement system to the 5 Washington state patrol retirement system:
- (i) All the employee's applicable accumulated contributions plus 6 7 interest, and an equal amount of employer contributions attributed to 8 such employee; and
- 9 (ii) All applicable months of service as a commercial vehicle 10 enforcement officer credited to the employee under this chapter as though that service was rendered as a member of the Washington state 11 12 patrol retirement system.
 - (b) For the applicable period of service, the employee shall pay:
- (i) The difference between the contributions the employee paid to 14 15 the retirement system, and the contributions which would have been paid by the employee had the employee been a member of the Washington state 16 patrol retirement system, plus interest as determined by the director. 17
- This payment shall be made no later than December 31, 2010, or the date 18 19 of retirement, whichever comes first;
- 20 (ii) The difference between the employer contributions paid to the public employees' retirement system, and the employer contributions 21 22 which would have been payable to the Washington state patrol retirement 23 system; and
- 24 (iii) An amount sufficient to ensure that the funding status of the 25 Washington state patrol retirement system will not change due to this transfer. 26
- 27 (c) If the payment required by this subsection is not paid in full by the deadline, the transferred service credit shall not be used to 28 determine eligibility for benefits nor to calculate benefits under the 29 Washington state patrol retirement system. In such case, the additional employee and employer contributions transferred under this subsection, and any payments made under this subsection, shall be 32 refunded to the employee, and the employer shall be entitled to a 33 credit for the payments made under (a) of this subsection. 34
- (d) An individual who transfers service credit and contributions 35 under this subsection is permanently excluded from the public 36 37 employees' retirement system for all service as a commercial vehicle enforcement officer. 38
