1 AN ACT Relating to crimes involving drivers' licenses and
2 identicards; amending RCW 46.20.0921; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.0921 and 1990 c 210 s 3 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) It is a misdemeanor for any person:

7 ~~((1))~~ (a) To display or cause or permit to be displayed or have
8 in his or her possession any fictitious or fraudulently altered
9 driver's license or identicard;

10 ~~((2))~~ (b) To lend his or her driver's license or identicard to
11 any other person or knowingly permit the use thereof by another;

12 ~~((3))~~ (c) To display or represent as one's own any driver's
13 license or identicard not issued to him or her;

14 ~~((4))~~ (d) Willfully to fail or refuse to surrender to the
15 department upon its lawful demand any driver's license or identicard
16 which has been suspended, revoked or canceled;

17 ~~((5))~~ (e) To use a false or fictitious name in any application
18 for a driver's license or identicard or to knowingly make a false

1 statement or to knowingly conceal a material fact or otherwise commit
2 a fraud in any such application;

3 ~~((6))~~ (f) To permit any unlawful use of a driver's license or
4 identicard issued to him or her.

5 (2) It is a class C felony for any person to manufacture, sell, or
6 deliver a forged, stolen, fictitious, counterfeit, fraudulently
7 altered, or unlawfully issued driver's license or identicard, or to
8 manufacture, sell, or deliver a blank driver's license or identicard
9 except under the direction of the department.

10 (3) In a proceeding under subsection (2) of this section that is
11 related to an identity theft under RCW 9.35.020, the crime will be
12 considered to have been committed in any locality where the person
13 whose means of identification or financial information was appropriated
14 resides, or in which any part of the offense took place, regardless of
15 whether the defendant was ever actually in that locality.
