- 1 AN ACT Relating to visitation for children in foster care; adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 13.34 RCW; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that contact between
- 5 children in foster care and their biological families is an important
- 6 component of the well-being and successful development of those
- 7 children. Visitation helps to alleviate the fears and anxieties that
- 8 many children in foster care experience, and thereby improves relations
- 9 and interactions between the children and both their foster and
- 10 biological families. Visitation can also improve the likelihood of
- 11 successful, lasting reunifications by providing the framework for the
- 12 development of appropriate parent-child relationships.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 13.34 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 The department of social and health services shall develop
- 16 consistent policies and protocols, based on current relevant research,
- 17 concerning visitation for children in foster care to be implemented
- 18 consistently throughout the state. The department shall develop the

- 1 policies and protocols in consultation with researchers in the field
- 2 and community-based agencies who provide related services in the state.
- 3 The policies and protocols shall include, but not be limited to: The
- 4 structure, quality, and frequency of visitations; and training for
- 5 caseworkers, visitation supervisors, and foster parents related to
- 6 visitation.
- 7 The policies and protocols shall be consistent with the provisions
- 8 of this chapter and implementation of the policies and protocols shall
- 9 be consistent with relevant orders of the court.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The department of social and health services
- 11 shall implement the policies and protocols required under section 2 of
- 12 this act across the state by January 1, 2005.
