2 "Sec. 14. RCW 84.52.068 and 2005 c 514 s 1104 are each amended
3 to read as follows:

4 (1) A portion of the proceeds of the state property tax levy
5 shall be deposited into the student achievement fund as provided in
6 this section.

7 (2)(a) The amount of the deposit shall be based upon the
8 average number of full-time equivalent students in the school
9 districts during the previous school year as reported to the office
10 of the superintendent of public instruction by August 31st of the
11 previous school year.

12 (b) (~~For the 2004-2005 through 2007-2008 school years, an~~
13 ~~annual amount equal to two hundred fifty-four dollars per full-time~~
14 ~~equivalent student in all school districts shall be deposited in~~

16 ~~(c) For the 2008-2009 school year, an annual amount equal to two~~
17 ~~hundred sixty-five dollars per full-time equivalent student in all~~

23 ~~(e) For the 2010-2011 school year and each year thereafter, an~~

26 ~~deposited in the student achievement fund)) For the 2005-06 school
27 year, an amount equal to three hundred dollars per full-time
28 equivalent student in all school districts shall be deposited in
29 the student achievement fund.~~

30 (c) For the 2006-07 school year, an amount equal to three

1 hundred seventy-five dollars per full-time equivalent student in
2 all school districts shall be deposited in the student achievement
3 fund.

4 (d) For the 2007-08 school year, an amount equal to four
5 hundred fifty dollars per full-time equivalent student in all
6 school districts shall be deposited in the student achievement fund.

7 (e) For each subsequent school year, the amount deposited per
8 full-time equivalent student shall be adjusted for inflation.

9 (f) The school district annual amounts shall be deposited based
10 on the monthly apportionment schedule as defined in RCW
11 28A.510.250. The office of the superintendent of public instruction
12 shall notify the department of the monthly amounts to be deposited
13 into the student achievement fund to meet the apportionment schedule.

14 (3) For the purposes of this section, "inflation" means the
15 percentage change in the implicit price deflator for the United
16 States for each fiscal year as published by the federal bureau of
17 labor statistics."

19 internal references accordingly.
