Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 47.80.060 and 1992 c 101 s 31 are each amended to 4 read as follows:

5 In order to qualify for state planning funds available to regional transportation planning organizations, the regional 6 transportation planning organizations containing any county with a 7 8 population in excess of one million shall provide voting membership 9 on its executive board to the state transportation commission, the 10 state department of transportation, and the ((three)) four largest 11 public port districts within the region as determined by gross 12 operating revenues. It shall further assure that at least fifty 13 percent of the county and city local elected officials who serve on 14 the executive board also serve on transit agency boards or on a 15 regional transit authority."

EFFECT: A Regional Transportation Planning Organization containing a county with more than one million population would have to add the fourth largest port district to its executive board in order to qualify for state funds.
