EFFECT: Removes the creation of salmon recovery regions in Puget Sound, the Yakima Basin, the Upper Columbia, and the Snake River. Authorizes lead entities to form regional salmon recovery organizations to plan, coordinate and monitor regional recovery plans. Removes specific language that the Legislature may designate additional salmon recovery regions, and authorizes the Salmon Recovery Office to recognize regional recovery organizations in regions where lead entities agree to form a regional organization.
