  23 December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical
  24 expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided
  25 that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the
  26 patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or
  27 physician assistant.
- 28 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 29 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as

- 1 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the
- 2 authority of an insurer to negotiate rates and contract with specific

- 9 (1) Each group disability insurance policy issued or renewed after 10 December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical 11 expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided 12 that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the 13 patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or 14 physician assistant.
- 15 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 16 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as 17 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the authority of an insurer to negotiate rates and contract with specific 18 19 providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening services. This 20 section shall not apply to medicare supplemental policies 21 supplemental contracts covering a specified disease or other limited 22 benefits.

  - (1) Each health care service contract issued or renewed after December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
- 31 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 32 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as 33 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the 34 authority of a contractor to negotiate rates and contract with specific 35 providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening services. This

  7 December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical
  8 expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided
  9 that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the
  10 patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or
  11 physician assistant.
- 12 (2) All services must be provided by the health maintenance 13 organization or rendered upon a referral by the health maintenance 14 organization.
  - (3) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the authority of a health maintenance organization to negotiate rates and contract with specific providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening services. This section shall not apply to medicare supplemental policies or supplemental contracts covering a specified disease or other limited benefits.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. A new section is added to chapter 48.125 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) Each self-funded multiple employer welfare arrangement established, operated, providing benefits, or maintained in this state after December 31, 2006, that provides coverage for hospital or medical expenses shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
- 32 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 33 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as 34 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the 35 authority of a self-funded multiple employer welfare arrangement to

- 1 negotiate rates and contract with specific providers for the delivery
- 2 of prostate cancer screening services.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** A new section is added to chapter 70.47 RCW 4 to read as follows:
  - (1) Any schedule of benefits established or renewed by the Washington basic health plan after December 31, 2006, shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant.
- 10 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent the application 11 of standard policy provisions applicable to other benefits, such as 12 deductible or copayment provisions. This section does not limit the 13 authority of the health care authority to negotiate rates and contract 14 with specific providers for the delivery of prostate cancer screening 15 services.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 8. A new section is added to chapter 74.09 RCW to read as follows:
- The department shall provide coverage for prostate cancer screening under this chapter, provided that the screening is delivered upon the recommendation of the patient's physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant."
