"(6) The Department of Licensing, in consultation with the Department of Transportation, Washington State Patrol, local law enforcement agencies, and other appropriate organizations, shall study the feasibility of creating a toll-free hotline for the public to report violations of accessible parking laws, including RCW 46.16.381 and 46.61.581. A report on the findings of this study is due to the transportation committees of the legislature by December 1, 2006, and shall include recommendations on how to disseminate and publicize information to the public that explains the existence, purpose, and method of accessing such a hotline, and how to partner with appropriate law enforcement agencies in the jurisdiction in which alleged violations occurred. In making recommendations regarding the potential establishment of accessible parking violation hotline, the Department of Licensing shall consider how to utilize or partner with existing statewide and regional hotlines."
