1 On page 8, line 25 insert the following:

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- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 9. (1)(a) A task force on off-road vehicle noise management is established. The task force consists of the following members:
- 6 (i) Two members from each of the two largest caucuses of the house 7 of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of 8 representatives;
- 9 (ii) Two members from each of the two largest caucuses of the 10 senate, appointed by the president of the senate; and
- 11 (iii) Participants invited by the legislative members, including 12 but not limited to persons representing the following:
 - (A) Three county commissioners, one representing counties with a population of two hundred thousand or more people and two representing counties with populations of fewer than two hundred thousand people;
 - (B) A representative of port districts;
- 17 (C) A representative of the department of natural resources, 18 selected by the commissioner of public lands;
- 19 (D) A representative of the department of ecology, selected by the 20 director of ecology;
 - (E) A representative of the interagency committee for outdoor recreation, selected by the director of the committee;
- 23 (F) A representative of the parks and recreation commission, 24 selected by the director of the commission;
 - (G) A person representing manufacturers of off-road vehicles;
 - (H) A representative of the United States forest service;
 - (I) Recreational users; and
- 28 (J) Interested citizens.
 - (b) The committee shall choose its chair from among its membership.
- 30 (2) The committee shall review the following issues:
- 31 (a) The appropriateness and enforceability of current decibel 32 requirements for off-road vehicles;
- 33 (b) The appropriateness of any off-road vehicle usage requirements

- that would minimize nuisance noise impacts on those not operating the off-road vehicle;
- 3 (c) The applicability and consistency of local ordinances 4 concerning noise and off-road vehicle usage; and
 - (d) The availability of, and barriers to, using public lands or other large ownerships to create areas where off-road vehicles can be operated with minimum noise disturbance of neighbors.
- 8 (3)(a) The committee shall be staffed by the house office of program research and senate committee services.
- 10 (b) Legislative members of the committee will be reimbursed for 11 travel expenses in accordance with RCW 44.04.120.
- 12 (4) The committee shall report its findings and recommendations in 13 the form of draft legislation to the legislature by December 1, 2005.
- 14 (5) This section expires July 1, 2006."
