"NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that active military 3 4 and naval veterans, reserve military and naval veterans, and national guard members called to active duty have served their country and have 5 6 risked their lives to defend the lives of all Americans and the freedoms that define and distinguish our nation. 7 The legislature 8 intends to honor active military and naval veterans, reserve military 9 and naval veterans, and national guard members who have served on 10 active military or naval duty for the public service they have provided to this country by making available to all eligible admitted veterans 11 12 a waiver of operating fees by a state university, a regional 13 university, The Evergreen State College, or the community colleges as 14 a whole, to veterans who qualify under RCW 28B.15.621.

15 Sec. 2. RCW 28B.15.910 and 2005 c 249 s 3 are each amended to read 16 as follows:

17 (1) For the purpose of providing state general fund support to public institutions of higher education, except for revenue waived 18 19 under programs listed in subsections (3) and (4) of this section, and 20 unless otherwise expressly provided in the omnibus state appropriations 21 act, the total amount of operating fees revenue waived, exempted, or 22 reduced by a state university, a regional university, The Evergreen State College, or the community colleges as a whole, shall not exceed 23 24 the percentage of total gross authorized operating fees revenue in this subsection. As used in this section, "gross authorized operating fees 25 26 revenue" means the estimated gross operating fees revenue as estimated 27 under RCW 82.33.020 or as revised by the office of financial 28 management, before granting any waivers. This limitation applies to all tuition waiver programs established before or after July 1, 1992. 29
