- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "Sec. 1. RCW 28B.10.350 and 2001 c 38 s 1 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
- (1) When the cost to The Evergreen State College, or any regional 5 university((-,)) or state university, of any building, construction, 6 7 renovation, remodeling, or demolition other than maintenance or repairs 8 will equal or exceed the sum of ((thirty five)) fifty thousand dollars, 9 complete plans and specifications for such work shall be prepared and 10 such work shall be put out for public bids and the contract shall be 11 awarded to the lowest responsible bidder if in accordance with the bid 12 specifications: PROVIDED, That when the estimated cost of such building, construction, renovation, remodeling, or demolition equals or 13 14 exceeds the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, such project shall be 15 deemed a public works and "the prevailing rate of wage," under chapter 16 39.12 RCW shall be applicable thereto: PROVIDED FURTHER, That when such building, construction, renovation, remodeling, or demolition 17 18 involves one trade or craft area and the estimated cost exceeds ((fifteen)) twenty thousand dollars, complete plans and specifications 19 20 for such work shall be prepared and such work shall be put out for 21 public bids, and the contract shall be awarded to the lowest 22 responsible bidder if in accordance with the bid specifications. 23 subsection shall not apply when a contract is awarded by the small 24 works roster procedure authorized in RCW 39.04.155 or under any other 25 procedure authorized for an institution of higher education.
 - (2) The Evergreen State College, any regional university, or state university may require a project to be put to public bid even when it is not required to do so under subsection (1) of this section.
 - (3) Where the estimated cost to The Evergreen State College, or any regional university((-)) or state university, of any building,

construction, renovation, remodeling, or demolition is less than twenty-five thousand dollars or the contract is awarded by the small works roster procedure authorized in RCW 39.04.155, the publication requirements of RCW 39.04.020 shall be inapplicable.

(4) In the event of any emergency when the public interest or property of The Evergreen State College, regional university, or state university would suffer material injury or damage by delay, the president of such college or university may declare the existence of such an emergency and reciting the facts constituting the same may waive the requirements of this section with reference to any contract in order to correct the condition causing the emergency: PROVIDED, That an "emergency," for the purposes of this section, means a condition likely to result in immediate physical injury to persons or to property of such college or university in the absence of prompt remedial action or a condition which immediately impairs the institution's ability to perform its educational obligations.

Sec. 2. RCW 28B.50.330 and 1993 c 379 s 108 are each amended to read as follows:

The boards of trustees of college districts are empowered in accordance with the provisions of this chapter to provide for the construction, reconstruction, erection, equipping, demolition, and major alterations of buildings and other capital assets, and the acquisition of sites, rights-of-way, easements, improvements, appurtenances for the use of the aforementioned colleges as authorized by the college board in accordance with RCW 28B.50.140; to be financed by bonds payable out of special funds from revenues hereafter derived from income received from such facilities, gifts, bequests, or grants, and such additional funds as the legislature may provide, and payable out of a bond retirement fund to be established by the respective district boards in accordance with rules and regulations of the state board. With respect to building, improvements, or repairs, or other work, where the estimated cost exceeds ((twenty-five)) fifty thousand dollars, complete plans and specifications for such work shall be prepared and such work shall be put out for public bids and the contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder if in accordance with the bid specifications: PROVIDED, That when such building, construction, renovation, remodeling, or demolition involves

- 1 one trade or craft area and the estimated cost exceeds ((ten)) twenty
- 2 thousand dollars, complete plans and specifications for such work shall
- 3 be prepared and such work shall be put out for public bids, and the
- 4 contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder if in
- 5 accordance with the bid specifications. This subsection shall not
- 6 apply when a contract is awarded by the small works procedure
- 7 authorized in ((RCW 39.04.150)) state law: PROVIDED FURTHER, That any
- 8 project regardless of dollar amount may be put to public bid.
- 9 Where the estimated cost to any college of any building,
- 10 improvements, or repairs, or other work, is less than twenty-five
- 11 thousand dollars, the publication requirements of RCW 39.04.020 shall

- On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "education;" strike the
- 14 remainder of the title and insert "and amending RCW 28B.10.350 and
- 15 28B.50.330."

EFFECT: The amendment does four things:

- 1. Deletes community colleges from the first section of the bill because that section of law currently only addresses 4-year public institutions of higher education;
- 2. Adds to the bill the section of law that currently addresses the public bid process for community and technical colleges;
- 3. Raises the cost limits that address the public bid of public works projects at community and technical colleges to conform with the bill; and
 - 4. Removes a reference to an obsolete statute.
