

SSB 6508 - S AMD TO S AMD (S-5231.3/06) **118**

NOT ADOPTED 02/13/2006

1 Beginning on page 1, line 3 of the amendment, strike all of
2 sections 1 through 4, and insert the following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 43.19.642 and 2003 c 17 s 2 are each amended to read
4 as follows:

5 (1) All state agencies are encouraged to use a fuel blend of twenty
6 percent biodiesel and eighty percent petroleum diesel for use in
7 diesel-powered vehicles and equipment.

8 (2) Effective June 1, 2006, for agencies complying with the ultra-
9 low sulfur diesel mandate of the United States environmental protection
10 agency for on-highway diesel fuel, agencies shall use biodiesel as an
11 additive to ultra-low sulfur diesel for lubricity, provided that the
12 use of a lubricity additive is warranted and that the use of biodiesel
13 is comparable in performance and cost with other available lubricity
14 additives. The amount of biodiesel added to the ultra-low sulfur
15 diesel fuel shall be not less than two percent.

16 (3) Effective June 1, 2009, all state agencies combined are
17 required to use a minimum of twenty percent biodiesel, to be derived
18 from Washington grown feedstock to the maximum extent possible, as
19 compared to the total aggregate volume of all diesel purchases made by
20 state agencies for the operation of diesel-powered vehicles and
21 equipment."

22 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
23 internal references accordingly.

1 Beginning on page 3, line 15 of the amendment, strike all of
2 sections 5 through 9, and insert the following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.19 RCW
4 to read as follows:

5 The department of general administration must assist state agencies
6 seeking to meet the biodiesel fuel mandates in RCW 43.19.642 by
7 coordinating the purchase and delivery of biodiesel if requested by any
8 state agency. The department may use long-term contracts of up to ten
9 years to secure a sufficient and stable supply of biodiesel for use by
10 state agencies.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 43.19 RCW
12 to read as follows:

13 The department of general administration shall coordinate a
14 biodiesel technical assistance team, including representatives from the
15 department of agriculture, the department of ecology, the department of
16 community, trade, and economic development's energy policy division,
17 and Washington State University's energy program. The team shall
18 provide assistance to fleet managers and recommend best management
19 practices concerning the use of biodiesel."

NOT ADOPTED 02/13/2006

20 On page 5, line 2 of the title amendment, after "insert" strike the
21 remainder of the title amendment and insert "amending RCW 43.19.642;
22 and adding new sections to chapter 43.19 RCW."

EFFECT: Eliminates the statewide provisions concerning mandates for the use of biodiesel and ethanol. Adds a requirement that state agencies use up to 20% biodiesel, and to the maximum extent possible that fuel should be derived from Washington grown feedstock. GA will provide assistance to agencies in purchasing biodiesel and coordinate a biodiesel technical assistance team.
