- 5 WHEREAS, Without significant changes to the system, costs will 6 exceed revenues starting in 2018 and the system will not be able to pay 7 any benefits by 2042; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Anyone born after the year 1970 will not receive any 9 Social Security benefits if changes are not made to the system; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Not reforming the system will require a 50 percent tax 11 increase on every working American or a 30 percent benefit cut; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Allowing younger workers to invest a portion of their 13 income in personal retirement accounts will allow younger workers to 14 have a greater rate of return and retirement security; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Allowing younger workers to invest a portion of their 16 income in personal retirement accounts will avoid any benefits cut 17 and/or tax increases;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists request that our elected Representatives and Senators in the United States Congress support no increases in payroll taxes, no cuts to Social Security benefits, and optional Social Security personal retirement accounts.
