SSB 6241

As Passed Senate, February 17, 2006

Title: An act relating to transportation funding and appropriations.

Brief Description: Making 2006 supplemental transportation appropriations.

Background: The operating and capital expenses of state transportation agencies and programs are funded on a biennial basis by an omnibus transportation budget adopted by the Legislature in odd-numbered years. Additionally, supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium making various modifications to agency appropriations.

Summary of Bill: The 2005-07 biennial appropriations for various transportation agencies and programs are modified. (See Committee supporting documents for more detail.)
