The Washington state institute for public policy, in collaboration with the office of insurance commissioner, is 3 directed to complete an evaluation of the effect of this act. 4 The 5 study shall include the impacts on premiums paid by small business, the 6 number of firms offering coverage, and the number of employees covered 7 by small business. To the extent possible, the cost benefit analysis should also examine any relevant changes in employee productivity and 8 9 employee retention for the small business, and impacts on mental health service providers such as hospitals, and any associated reductions in 10 uncompensated care. The study shall examine at least two year's of 11 12 experience after implementation and be submitted to the legislature no later than December 1, 2011." 13
