The training shall be successfully completed prior to or within the first six months of employment, unless otherwise extended or waived by the commission, and shall be requisite to the continuation of employment.
  - (3)) The commission shall provide the training required in this section, together with facilities, supplies, materials, and the room and board for noncommuting attendees.
- $((\frac{4}{1}))$  (3) Nothing in this section shall affect or impair the employment status of any employee whose employer does not provide him with the opportunity to engage in the required training.
- **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.101.350 and 1997 c 351 s 10 are each amended to 28 read as follows:
- 29 (1) All law enforcement personnel initially hired to, transferred

- to, or promoted to a supervisory or management position on or after 1
- January 1, 1999, and all corrections personnel of the state and all 2
