- 19 (A) Construct a new pedestrian and bicycle bridge across I-5 at NE

- 21 (B) Construct a new pedestrian and bicycle bridge across I-90 at SR
- 22 900;
- 23 (C) Construct a new pedestrian and bicycle bridge across railroad
- 24 tracks at Military Road in south Seattle."

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EFFECT: Funds totaling \$12,950,000 that had been designated for the "Stanwood - Siding Upgrades" rail project are instead provided to construct pedestrian and bicycle paths across I-5 at NE 47th

Street, across I-90 at SR 900, and across the railroad tracks at Military Road in south Seattle.
